

C. Virtual Meetings

1. Virtual meetings may be conducted by email but must be documented and placed in the minutes of the next meeting.

**VIII. Activities**

- A. An event shall be defined as an activity that involves advertising, promotion, signage, posters or other developmental efforts and may include operating expenses.
- B. A tour of City Hall is understood to be of no cost to the corporation and is donated, as a service to the community in response to requests from individuals and groups.

**IX. Fiscal Year**

- A. The fiscal year of the Board shall be October 1 to September 30.

**X. Gifts, Bequests, Donations.**

- A. Friends of City Hall welcomes financial gifts of all sorts but also reserves the right to refuse proffered gifts, bequests and donations.

**XI. Dissolution of Corporation**

- A. Should Friends of City Hall dissolve all assets, real and personal property shall revert to the Community Pride and heritage Museum, 505 S. Maine Street, P.O. Box 184, Marine City, MI 48039, which is a 501(c)3 corporation, number 38-2049751.

**XII. Amendments**

- A. These bylaws may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the membership provided a Board quorum is present and the membership has been provided with the amendment a minimum of one week prior to the meeting.

**XIII. Bylaws Review**

- A. The Bylaws shall be reviewed every three years. ( 2019, 2022, 2025, etc. )

**XIV. Not for Profit Status**

- A. It is intended that Friends of City Hall remain a nonprofit corporation in perpetuity. No action can be taken or amendment devised that changes the nonprofit nature of this corporation.
